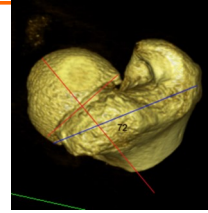

#### Workshops

**Arthroscopy:** You will work on hip cadavers and practice techniques such as fixing labrum with knot less suture anchors and osteoplasty.

**Pelvic Osteotomy:** This involves doing osteotomy on cadaver pelvis, and practicing the concepts learnt on the course.

**Case Discussions:** This will involve discussing cases with particular emphasis on decision making.
